

HOW TO GET TO BUDAPEST

BY PLANE

Flights arrive at Budapest Airport (Liszt Ferenc International Airport)

AIRPORT MINIBUS

The AirportShuttle-Minibus Desks are to be found at every terminal (Terminal 1, Terminal 2A and 2B), all Minibuses arrive to and depart from the Terminals' Main Entrance.

Reservations can be made in person at the AirportShuttle-Minibus Desks or at least 12 hours before your flight departure via online reservation system www.airportshuttle.hu, or by calling the Call Center by dialing the number (+36-1) 296-8555.

Every vehicle is equipped with dual-air conditioning systems and free Wi-Fi hotspots for gratis internet access, further increasing the passenger comfort during the journey.

PUBLIC AIRPORT BUS

100E

Bus line 100E is running between **Liszt Ferenc International Airport** and **Deák Ferenc square (Deák tér)** in the city centre. It has two stops at **Kálvin square (Kálvin tér)** and **Astoria**. A special fare applies: the "Airport shuttle bus single ticket" for the price of HUF 900 is required for each trip, other tickets or season tickets are not valid for this service.

TAXI

Főtaxi, the taxi company with the longest traditions in Hungary transports passengers between the terminals and Budapest. Reservations can be made in person at the Főtaxi booths located at the exits at Terminals 2A and 2B. At the taxi rank in front of the stands, taxis are parking continuously waiting for passengers. A ride to the city center should typically cost around 7000 HUF (22 EUR) depending on traffic conditions.

Please be aware of exposing yourself at risk by using non-regulated taxi service providers soliciting at the terminal buildings.
